

CASABLANCA Smart Edit 6

6.2 Release Notes / DVD Arabesk 4.0c



SE 6.2C

- This update is optimized for the DVD-Arabesk 4 software.
- For those with Casablanca models that use Products CD's (to activate Smart Edit software in the Install Product menu), your Smart Edit 6 code will be requested during the activation process. Have this on hand when updating or installing to this version. If you have lost this number, contact Macrosystem and have your serial number handy.
- A patch has been added to fix the clipboard function.
- Improvements made to audio sync when using the DV Backup mode to archive a storyboard on CD/DVD or DV tape.
- A problem in proper hard drive partitioning has been fixed to allow some Casablanca models to set up the correct space for DVD Arabesk during the full installation of Smart Edit 6.
- Some patches made to the audio sync on HDV output with the final rendering from the finish menu.
- More improvements to scene (auto) splitting after importing HDV footage.
- For new users of Smart Edit 6, please see the release notes of Smart Edit 6.1 as some other issues are the same.

Additional Notes:

- Please use version Smart Edit 6.2c or above when working with Arabesk 4. Smart Edit 5 and above can activate the program, but will not operate all Arabesk 4 menu controls properly.
- When using some of the new default DVD templates, be aware that some templates will have a set pattern and name to the buttons (like "play"). These can of course be changed manually if needed in the Edit Menu.
- Multi-Angle will take audio from each camera angle (the manual indicates it comes from just Angle 1).
- Multi angle function only allows the video quality to be Normal and the audio quality to be compressed. There are no Chapter Menu options in this feature.
- Assistant mode allows no choice for audio compression. It will be set to compressed.

Known Issues of ARABESK 4.0c

- Once in the Chapter Menu, moving a stamp or button behind the actual menu itself makes the button seem to disappear.
- During the Add Film or menu creation process, distortions may appear on the screen on some Casablanca models. This will not cause any harm to the projects or menus and is just a display issue.
- Some button activation highlights may appear slightly off in the virtual DVD preview menu (All menu).
- The virtual DVD preview menu (All menu) is not able to preview stamps that have an action set to go directly to the chapter menu. The system may freeze or give an error and re-boot if this is tried.
- There is not a current “flag” in the program to make a burnt disc allow the actual 16x9 formatted projects to immediately be seen by a DVD player. The DVD player may require its menu to change in order to see the project properly formatted for the TV.
- Some parts of this program, like the Multi-Angle function, use large portions of internal memory. To avoid any system shutdowns due to this problem, try shutting down manually and re-booting before entering the Arabesk 4 especially if the films or projects are large.
- Some Multi-Angle projects may produce a subtle clicking noise on playback of the burnt DVD on additional camera angles.
- There are some problems using the ‘Successive’ and ‘Repeated’ film playback controls.
- Auto minimize sizing on the buttons (or stamps) is currently not working
- Buttons with 3 lines of text in Chapter menus can cause a Film to freeze during the Add Film process.
- Arranging the order of rendered films in the “Films/ Chapters” menu may alter the playback on the main menu.
- Longer films added into Arabesk will still give minute Chapter intervals, even though during the Chapter Menu process for Chapters the choice “None” was selected for the film.
- You may get digital artifacts or audio drop out lately after adding films. Delete and re-add.
- Deleting Arabesk 4 from the Install Product menu and installing Arabesk 3 may cause problems on burned DVDs.
- The 16x9 tag for films not active. A burned DVD requires the physical menu adjustment to 16x9 on the DVD player to see it properly. It does not automatically adjust from our Arabesk burned DVD's
